ORDER

On April 10, 2013, this Court issued a Memorandum and Order retaining jurisdiction over Plaintiff Wyandotte Nation's remaining claim of unreasonable delay until the Defendant Secretary of the United States Department of Interior issues a final ruling on the Nation's pending trust acquisition application (Doc. 83). The Secretary filed a Fifth Status Report on July 8, 2014 (Doc. 94), attaching the decision issued on July 3, 2014, by the Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs denying the Nation's application to acquire the Park City Land in trust.

On July 9, 2014, this Court issued a Notice and Order to Show Cause (Doc. 95) directing the Nation to show cause why any remaining claims in this lawsuit should not be dismissed as moot. The Nation has responded that it does not object to the Court's dismissal of the remaining claim of unreasonable delay raised in Count II as moot. Accordingly,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COURT with Judgment to follow.
