INDICTMENT

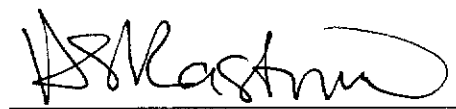
The Grand Jury charges:

On or about January 30, 2014, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **CLARA BETH JOE**, an Indian, unlawfully killed and caused the death of John Doe, by carelessly and heedlessly failing to care for John Doe in willful and wanton disregard of the rights and safety of John Doe and without due caution and circumspection and with a wanton and reckless disregard for human life when she knew and should have known that her conduct imperiled the life of John Doe.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 1112.
