COUNT 1

18 U.S.C. § 2241(c)
(Aggravated Sexual Abuse of a Child)

On a date unknown to the Grand Jury between 2009 and February 14, 2010, in the
Central Division of the District of Utah,

RICHARD JENKS, JR.,

the defendant herein, an enrolled member of the Ute Indian Tribe, while within the
boundaries of the Uintah and Ouray Reservation, did knowingly engage in a sexual act

with Victim A, a child under the age of 12 years, and attempted to do so; all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2241(c) and 1153.

COUNT 2

18 U.S.C. § 2241(c)
(Aggravated Sexual Abuse of a Child)

On a date unknown to the Grand Jury between 2009 and February 14, 2010, in the Central Division of the District of Utah,

RICHARD JENKS, JR.,

the defendant herein, an enrolled member of the Ute Indian Tribe, while within the boundaries of the Uintah and Ouray Reservation, did knowingly engage in a sexual act with Victim A, a child under the age of 12 years, and attempted to do so; all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2241(c) and 1153.

COUNT 3

18 U.S.C. § 2243(a)
(Sexual Abuse of a Minor)

On a date unknown to the Grand Jury between February 15, 2010 and September 2014, in the Central Division of the District of Utah,

RICHARD JENKS, JR.,

the defendant herein, an enrolled member of the Ute Indian Tribe, while within the boundaries of the Uintah and Ouray Reservation, did knowingly engage in a sexual act with Victim A, a person who had attained the age of 12 years but had not attained the age of 16 years and is more than four years younger than defendant, and attempted to do so; all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2243(a) and 1153(a).

COUNT 4
18 U.S.C. § 2243(a)
(Sexual Abuse of a Minor)

On a date unknown to the Grand Jury between February 15, 2010 and September 2014, in the Central Division of the District of Utah,

RICHARD JENKS, JR.,

the defendant herein, an enrolled member of the Ute Indian Tribe, while within the boundaries of the Uintah and Ouray Reservation, did knowingly engage in a sexual act with Victim A, a person who had attained the age of 12 years but had not attained the age of 16 years and is more than four years younger than defendant, and attempted to do so; all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 2243(a) and 1153(a).
