INDICTMENT

U.S.C. §111(a)(1) and (b)

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT I


On or about the 17th day of October, 2014, in the District of Nebraska, the defendant, THOMAS WHITE, JR., did voluntarily and intentionally forcibly assault, resist, oppose, impede, intimidate, and interfere with J.M., a police officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs Office of Justice Services, an agency within the United States Department of the Interior, in that the defendant resisted arrest by: (a) failing to comply with the officer's demands, (b) charging at the officer and striking the officer in the face and body, and (c) attempting to avoid being handcuffed, all while the officer was engaged in his official duties, and, in the course of doing so, did cause bodily injuries to said officer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 111(a)(1) and (b).
