

INDICTMENT

The Federal Grand Jury charges:

<u>Count 1</u> (Murder in the Second Degree)

On or about December 23, 2013, within Indian Country, as defined in Title

18, United States Code, Section 1151, more specifically on an Indian allotment under the

jurisdiction of the Sac and Fox Nation, in the Western District of Oklahoma,

an Indian, did unlawfully kill Marshall Scott Dent, an Indian, with malice aforethought and with callous and wanton disregard for human life, by beating and striking Marshall Scott Dent with his fists, feet, and a firearm.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1153 and Title 18, United States Code, Section 1111.

<u>Count 2</u> (Possession of a Firearm in Furtherance of a Crime of Violence)

On or about December 23, 2013, in the Western District of Oklahoma,

-----GEORGE EDMOND WALKER-----

knowingly and intentionally possessed a Ruger .22 rifle, Model 10/22, bearing serial number 355-48672, in furtherance of a crime of violence for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, murder in the second degree, as described in Count 1.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1)(A), the penalty for which is found at Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(c)(1)(A)(i).

<u>Count 3</u> (Felon in Possession of a Firearm)

On or about December 23, 2013, in the Western District of Oklahoma,

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), the penalty for which is found at Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(a)(2).

<u>Count 4</u> (Accessory after the Fact)

On or about December 23, 2013, through on or about December 29, 2013, in the Western District of Oklahoma,

-----ANNE MARIE JOHNSON,-----

knowing that an offense against the United States had been committed, to wit, the killing of another individual, as described in Count 1, did receive, relieve, comfort and assist the offender, George Edmond Walker, in order to hinder and prevent the offender's apprehension, trial, and punishment.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3.

FORFEITURE

A. The allegations contained in this Indictment are hereby re-alleged and _ incorporated by reference for the purposes of alleging forfeiture.

B. Upon conviction of either offense alleged in Count 2 or Count 3 of this Indictment, defendant **GEORGE EDMOND WALKER** shall forfeit to the United States any firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of the offense, including but not limited to:

1. Ruger .22 rifle, Model 10/22, bearing serial number 355-48672; and

2. Any and all ammunition or magazines not specifically listed.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d) and Title 28,

United States Code, Section 2461(c).
