EMBEZZLEMENT FROM INDIAN TRIBAL ORGANIZATIONS [18 U.S.C. § 1163]

From on or about March 26, 2005 and continuing through April 2, 2011, in the Eastern District of Oklahoma, the defendant, **CARMA LYNN ELLIOTT**, with intent to convert them to her use, did knowingly retain \$585,397.15 of moneys, funds and credits belonging to the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, a tribal organization, knowing them to have been willfully misapplied, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1163.
