## TEMPORARY RETRAINING ORDER

Upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order and Motion for a Preliminary Injunction to Ensure the Protection of Individual Indian Trust Data, the parties' responses, replies and the entire record of this case, it is by this Court hereby,

ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Interior defendants immediately shall disconnect from the Internet all information technology systems which house or provide access to individual Indian trust data until such time as the Special Master has determined that all Individual Indian Trust data is properly secured; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Interior defendants immediately shall disconnect from the Internet all computers within the custody and control of the Department of the Interior, its employees and contractors, that house or provide access to individual Indian trust data until such time as the Special Master has determined that Individual Indian Trust data is properly secured; and it is

FURTHER URDERED that Interior defendants immediately shall cease and desist from further obstruction of the Special Master in the discharge of all duties conferred upon him by this Court:
