INDICTMENT

The Federal Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

**THEFT BY OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES OF GAMING  
ESTABLISHMENT ON INDIAN LANDS  
[18 U.S.C. § 1168(b)]**

From in or about December 2014, to on or about August 17, 2015, in the Eastern District of Oklahoma, **CHARLES BLAIR SMALLWOOD**, defendant herein, while an employee of the Choctaw Nation Casino and Resort, in Indian Country did embezzle, abstract, purloin, willfully misapply, and take and carry away with intent to steal any moneys, funds, assets, or other property in excess of \$1,000.00 belonging to the Choctaw Nation Casino and Resort, an Indian gaming establishment operated by the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma pursuant to an ordinance or resolution approved by the National Indian Gaming Commission in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1168(b).
