did embezzle, steal, knowingly convert to his own use or the use of another, and willfully misapply property of an Indian tribe, with the value exceeding \$1,000.

In particular, defendant took the cash proceeds from the Quality Inn & Suites, which is owned by the Nottawaseppi Huron Band of Pottawatomi, which taking was not authorized or approved by the tribal government. The defendant's actions (1) deprived the members of the tribe of moneys, funds, assets, and property; and (2) deprived the members of the tribe of the right to make decisions about how the moneys, funds, assets, and property were to be used. The amount taken was over \$1,000.
