
**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:**

That on or about November 15, 2015, at Lame Deer, in the State and District of Montana, the defendant, WENONAH SUE WAGNER, being an employee of the Charging Horse Casino and Bingo, a gambling establishment owned and operated by the Northern Cheyenne Tribe of Indians pursuant to an ordinance and


resolution approved by the National Indian Gaming Commission, did embezzle, abstract, purloin, willfully misapply, and take with the intent to steal, moneys, funds, assets, and other property of such establishment of a value in excess of \$1,000, namely, taking \$23,000 in cash without authorization, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1168(b).
