Upon consideration of the motion to stay filed by plaintiffs-appellees Aquinnah/Gay Head Community Association, Inc. and the Town of Aquinnah and plaintiff-appellee the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, as well as the motion to join plaintiffs-appellees' motion to stay, filed by third party defendants Charles D. Baker, Maura T. Healey and Stephen P. Crosby, the motions are granted.
