FIRST SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

(Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Prohibited Person)

Between on or about January 11, 2013, through on or about October 24, 2014, at
Tulalip, and elsewhere, within the Western District of Washington, RAYMOND LEE
FRYBERG, JR. who was subject to a court order meeting the requirements of Title 18,
United States Code, Section 922(g)(8)(A)-(C), that is, an Order for Protection issued on
September 10, 2002, by the Tulalip Tribal Court for the Tulalip Tribes of Washington,
case number TUL-TRO-8/02-415, did possess a firearm, to wit: one Mossberg, model
500, 12 gauge shotgun, serial number U208871, that had been previously shipped and
transported in interstate and foreign commerce.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8).

COUNT 2**(Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Prohibited Person)**

Between on or about January 23, 2013, through on or about October 24, 2014, at Tulalip, and elsewhere, within the Western District of Washington, RAYMOND LEE FRYBERG, JR. who was subject to a court order meeting the requirements of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8)(A)-(C), that is, an Order for Protection issued on September 10, 2002, by the Tulalip Tribal Court for the Tulalip Tribes of Washington, case number TUL-TRO-8/02-415, did possess a firearm, to wit: a Beretta, model PX4 Storm, bearing serial number PZ72254, that had been previously shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8).

COUNT 3**(Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Prohibited Person)**

Between on or about March 14, 2013, through on or about October 24, 2014, at Tulalip, and elsewhere, within the Western District of Washington, RAYMOND LEE FRYBERG, JR. who was subject to a court order meeting the requirements of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8)(A)-(C), that is, an Order for Protection issued on September 10, 2002, by the Tulalip Tribal Court for the Tulalip Tribes of Washington, case number TUL-TRO-8/02-415, did possess a firearm, to wit: BFI model Carbon-15, 5.56 NATO rifle, serial number CRB053485, that had been previously shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8).

COUNT 4**(Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Prohibited Person)**

Between on or about March 21, 2013, through on or about October 24, 2014, at Tulalip, and elsewhere, within the Western District of Washington, RAYMOND LEE FRYBERG, JR. who was subject to a court order meeting the requirements of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8)(A)-(C), that is, an Order for Protection issued on

13 | case number TUL-TRO-8/02-415, did possess a firearm, to wit: Savage Arms, model
14 | 93R17, .17 HMR, rifle, serial number 2329758, that had been previously shipped and
15 | transported in interstate and foreign commerce.

16 | All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8).

18 | **(Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Prohibited Person)**

19 | On or about March 30, 2015, at Tulalip, and elsewhere, within the Western
20 | District of Washington, RAYMOND LEE FRYBERG, JR. who was subject to a court
21 | order meeting the requirements of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(8)(A)-
22 | (C), that is, an Order for Protection issued on September 10, 2002, by the Tulalip Tribal
23 | Court for the Tulalip Tribes of Washington, case number TUL-TRO-8/02-415, did
24 | possess firearms, to wit:

- 25 | - one Ruger .280 caliber rifle, serial number 134-40664
26 | - one Tikka, model T3, .300 caliber rifle, serial number 766476
27 | - one Thompson Center .308 caliber rifle, serial number U059663
28 | - one Marlin, model X-T17, .17 caliber rifle, serial number MM26481A

1 - one Winchester, model 70, .264 caliber rifle, serial number 35CZy12330
2 each of which had been previously shipped and transported in interstate and foreign
3 commerce.




