ORDER

Upon review of the record, and the Parties’ oral motion of this same date, the Court finds as follows:

(1) The Parties have informed the Court that they have reached a settlement agreement resolving all the issues in the above-referenced case.

(2) The Parties also have informed the Court that they will move to dismiss the above-captioned matter at a later date in conformance with the settlement agreement reached by the Parties.

(3) On January 12, 2012, the Court entered a confidentiality order (Agreed Mediation Order [Doc. 58]), which was superseded and replaced by an amended confidentiality order (Agreed Confidentiality Order [Doc. 140]) on December 23, 2015. Based on the settlement reached by the Parties, there is no further reason for the Agreed Confidentiality Order to remain in effect.


(4) The United States, in its capacity as trustee for the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma and the Chickasaw Nation and their members, and in its role as a party in Case No. CIV-12-275-W, is not a Party to this case, but has an interest in the settlement negotiations in this case and has voluntarily consented to be bound by the terms of the Agreed Confidentiality Order [Doc. 140]. The United States has been consulted and does not object to this Order.

(5) This case should remain stayed in accordance with all the terms of prior stays pending a motion to dismiss filed by the Parties in conformance with the settlement agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) The Agreed Confidentiality Order entered on December 23, 2015, is of no further force or effect.
- (2) This case shall remain stayed pursuant to the terms of the prior stays the Court has entered in this case.
- (3) The Parties shall file a motion to dismiss this action at the appropriate time in conformance with the settlement agreement.
