## **DECLARATION OF COUNSEL**

## I, Rachel Lederman, declare:

The Complaint and Motion for Temporary Restraining Order were filed in this matter on Monday November 28, 2016. Plaintiffs did not seek to have the TRO entered ex parte but promptly retained process server W.T. Butcher and Associates in Bismarck to serve all of the defendants as expeditiously as possible.

On Tuesday, November 29, 2016, there was a blizzard in Bismarck and Mandan and only emergency vehicles were allowed on portions of the road. Nevertheless, that day William Butcher was able to personally serve Defendants Stutsman County and Stutsman County Sheriff Chad Kaiser, Morton County, the City of Mandan, and Mandan Police Chief Jason Ziegler.

On November 30, 2016, Mr. Butcher went to the office of Sheriff Kyle Kirchmeier and waited on two occasions to serve him personally. Although he was present in his office, Sheriff

Kirchmeier did not make himself available for personal service. On the morning of December 1, the Morton County States Attorney accepted service on behalf of Sheriff Kirchmeier.

As of the morning of December 1, all Defendants were served and Notice of Service was filed on Dec. 1.

The need for emergency relief and threat of irreparable harm set forth in Plaintiffs' previous papers has only increased since this action was filed three days ago. In fact there are thousands more people at the Oceti Šakowin Camp, and the United States Army Corps of Engineers has given a deadline of December 5, 2016, for the water protectors to relocate off the United States Army Corps land where approximately 9,000 people are currently camped. This has brought an increasing number of supporters to the camp making a further confrontation quite likely in the coming days.
