The Grand Jury Charges:

COUNT I

On or about September 29, 2016, at Pine Ridge, in Indian country, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Orlando Guadalupe Jose Ephron Villanueva de Macias, a/k/a "Chris," with malice aforethought did unlawfully kill Chunta Suta Wi Colhoff, a/k/a Annie Colhoff, an Indian, by shooting her with a firearm, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ and 1111(a) and 1152.

COUNT II

On or about September 29, 2016, at Pine Ridge, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Orlando Guadalupe Jose Ephron Villanueva de Macias, a/k/a "Chris," during and in relation to a crime of violence for which he could

be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, second degree murder, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ and 1111(a) and 1152, did use and carry and discharge a firearm, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 924(c)(1)(A)(iii).

COUNT III

On or about September 29, 2016, at Pine Ridge, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Orlando Guadalupe Jose Ephron Villanueva de Macias, a/k/a "Chris," having been previously convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for more than one year, did knowingly possess ammunition, which had been previously shipped and transported in interstate and foreign commerce, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1).
