

# GENERAL ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY & APPLICATION INFORMATION

The Bureau of Indian Affairs is accepting applications for General Assistance from individuals residing within the Nooksack service area (Whatcom & Skagit counties) who are enrolled in a federally recognized tribe. Eligibility will be determined on an individual basis and is based, in large part, on household income.
