The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT I

First-Degree Murder within Indian Country
 (18 U.S.C. §§ 1111(a) and 1153)

On or about November 30 2015, in the Central Division of the District of Utah,

TIMOTHY LEE SMITH,

the defendant herein, an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation while within the boundaries
 of the Navajo Nation Reservation, willfully, deliberately, maliciously, and with premeditation

and malice aforethought, did unlawfully kill Maranny Hatalie Holiday by shooting her; in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1111(a) and 1153.

COUNT II

Felon in Possession of a Firearm
(18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1))

On or about November 30, 2015, in the Central Division of the District of Utah,

TIMOTHY LEE SMITH,

defendant herein, having been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for more than one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm, to wit, a .22 caliber pistol; in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1).
