**INDICTMENT**

The Federal Grand Jury charges:

**Introduction**

At all times relevant to this Indictment:

1. The Comanche Nation of Oklahoma (“the Tribe”) was a federally recognized Indian tribal organization headquartered in Lawton, Oklahoma.
2. The Comanche Nation Tax Commission (“Tax Commission”) was an organization of the Tribe under the Comanche General Revenue and Taxation Act of 1995 to oversee taxation issues and to allow the Tribe to fund governmental operations.
3. The defendant, Julierose Baquera Molina, was an employee of the Tax Commission during the time specified in the Indictment.

**The Offense**

4. From or about October 2014 through March 2016, in Comanche County,


within the Western District of Oklahoma,

the defendant herein, being an employee of the Comanche Nation Tax Commission, an Indian tribal organization, knowingly embezzled, stole, converted to her use and the use of another, willfully misapplied, and willfully permitted to be misapplied the moneys, funds, credits, goods, assets, and other property belonging to the Tax Commission, in an amount over \$1,000.00.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1163.
