Discharge of a Firearm during the
Commission of a Crime of Violence
(18 U.S.C. § 924(c)(1)(A)(iii))

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT I

On or about February 10, 2018, near Kyle, in Indian country, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Tiffany Janis, an Indian person, did unlawfully and with malice aforethought kill Brian Garrett, by shooting him with a firearm, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1111(a) and 1153.

COUNT II

On or about February 10, 2018, near Kyle, in the District of South Dakota, the defendant, Tiffany Janis, knowingly discharged a firearm during and in relation to a crime of violence for which she could be prosecuted in a court of the United States, that is, Second Degree Murder, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1111(a) and 1153, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 924(c)(1)(A)(iii).
