The Grand Jury charges that

COUNT I

On or about April 23, 2017, within the exterior boundaries of the Winnebago Indian Reservation in the District of Nebraska, the defendants JEREMIAH M. WOLFE, an Indian male, NATASHA M. WOLFE, an Indian female, and LAWRENCIA L. MERRICK, an Indian female, with malice aforethought did unlawfully kill W.R., an Indian male, by striking, kicking, beating, and strangling W.R.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1111, 1153, and 2.

COUNT II

On or about April 23, 2017, within the exterior boundaries of the Winnebago Indian Reservation in the District of Nebraska, the defendant, NATASHA M. WOLFE, an Indian female, knowing that an offense against the United States had been committed, to wit, the unlawful killing with malice aforethought of W.R., an Indian male, did receive, relieve, comfort, and assist the offenders, JEREMIAH M. WOLFE and LAWRENCIA L. MERRICK, in order to hinder and prevent the offender's apprehension, trial, and punishment.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3.
