FACTUAL BASIS STATEMENT

The Defendant states the following facts are true, and the parties agree that they establish a factual basis for the offense(s) to which Defendant is pleading guilty pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 11(b)(3).

K.S. was born on xx/xx/2013 to the defendant, Katrina Shangreaux, a/k/a Katrina White Whirlwind, and James Shangreaux Sr. Shangreaux is an enrolled member of the Oglala Sioux Tribe. In late July 2016, K.S. was living with Shangreaux in Evergreen Housing, Porcupine, South Dakota, within the exterior boundaries of the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation. Dubray is Shangreaux's mother. Shangreaux was not always K.S.'s primary custodian; K.S. lived with his paternal aunt for a large portion of his life. Shangreaux's relationship with K.S.'s paternal family was strained.

On July 27, 2016, or into the morning hours of July 28, 2016, Shangreaux returned home after apparently consuming excessive amounts of alcohol. Dubray agrees the evidence shows Shangreaux became enraged and then beat and killed K.S.

Shangreaux and Dubray cleaned the K.S.'s body, changed his clothes and cleaned up the scene. Shangreaux and Dubray called for help after cleaning up. Shangreaux fled and Dubray met her later that day and provided Shangreaux a cell phone. Dubray took K.S.'s soiled clothing and laundered them in Gordon, Nebraska. Dubray was aware, at the time she cleaned up K.S.'s body, the murder scene, and laundered K.S.'s clothes that Shangreaux had committed the crime of murder.

Dubray made materially false statements to the Federal Bureau of Investigation during the initial investigation into K.S.'s murder, in order to assist her daughter in evading arrest.
